Notice from Calderdale Public Health to share with parents/carers and staff

This year, there has been a national increase in measles. Although there are no cases in Calderdale at present, vaccination rates are low in some areas, which means that if we do get a case it is more likely to spread. Measles can be very serious for some people, but the good news is that it can be avoided by getting a vaccination.

If you're not sure if you have been vaccinated, you can check your records on the NHS app or you can check your children's vaccination record in their red book. Alternatively, you can check with your GP.

If you or your family have not been vaccinated it is not too late. Contact your GP and they will book you in for a first dose followed by the second dose 2 months later to ensure you are fully protected.
