Electronic Health Needs Assessment (eHNA)

We have been asked by the Director of Public Health and the Director of Children's Services to take part in a local **Pupil Health and Wellbeing survey**.

We will be asking all children in Year 5 and Year 6 to complete an online survey, asking a range of questions about their health and wellbeing. The survey has been developed with input from local head teachers and health professionals, so is suitable for this age group.

The survey will take about 20 to 30 minutes and will be done in school. The survey is confidential, and children aren't asked for their name or any other personal data.

The aim of the pupil health and wellbeing survey is to give an overview of the health and wellbeing of children and young people in Calderdale, which will help services to plan and deliver support in a way that will best meet local needs.
