### CHRISTMAS CELEBRATIONS

The dates for our Christmas Week Celebrations have been finalised and added to the website site parent calendar, but as we look toward the festive period I would like to give you some details of the various events that we are planning.

Tickets (where applicable) can be requested by completing the online form that will be emailed to the first priority contact on your data collection sheet today and submitting this by 4<sup>th</sup> December.

Once we have established the numbers of tickets claimed for each performance, it might be that there are spares available. If this is the case, we will send everyone a text on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> December and invite you to request a further ticket via an online form which will be opened at 7pm.

Given the current economic climate there will be no charge for tickets this year. However, if you can make a donation in lieu of tickets this year this will be gratefully received and used to buy resources to complement our curriculum. Donations can be made via the item in the Shop section of SchoolMoney. You do not need to print out anything regarding your ticket allocation; we will have a list on the door.

Please note that 'babes in arms' (ie those under the age of 2 years) do not need a ticket allocating if they are sitting on a parent's knee for the performance. Children aged 2 and over will need a ticket to attend.

#### Tuesday 13<sup>th</sup> December - Pre-School Nativity

Children will take part in a performance in the school hall at **9:30am**. Due to the capacity in the hall there will initially be **three** tickets available per family. Pre-School children who do not normally attend on a Tuesday can be brought in to take part and should arrive at Pre-School for 9:15am. Please let Pre-School know if you will be bringing your child for the performance.

#### Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December – Reception and Year 1 Nativity

Children will take part in two performances in the school hall at **9:30am** and **6pm**. Due to the capacity in the hall there will initially be **two** tickets available per family for each
