







This week in Pre-school, we have been focusing on repeating patterns and writing our names. We have also been exploring different textures in our sensory tray.




Year 1 have been working hard to create their own kindness keyrings to sell for our enterprise. At each stage of the process we worked carefully and cooperatively to create the best products we could.
