Year 2 have worked hard this week creating their thumb pot. First, we practised the technique using salt dough then we used clay. Next week we will decorate them using an African inspired print.



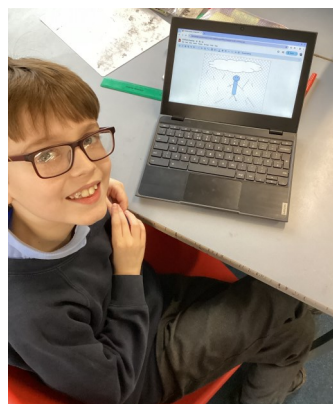
