



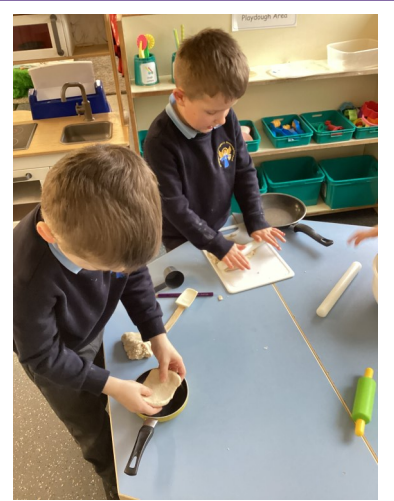

We have been enjoying the start of our 'Under the Sea' theme in Pre-School. The children have explored a seaside sensory activity as well as creating fish whilst counting their scales.

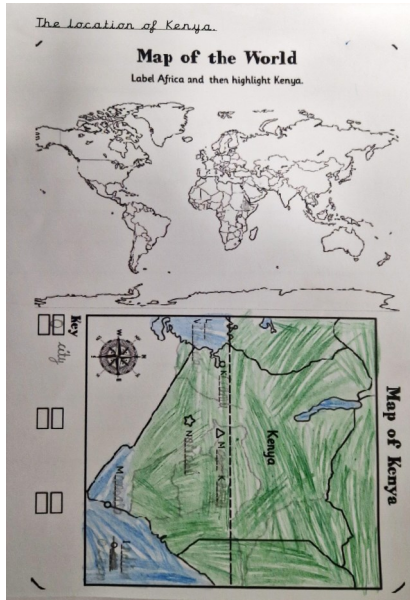

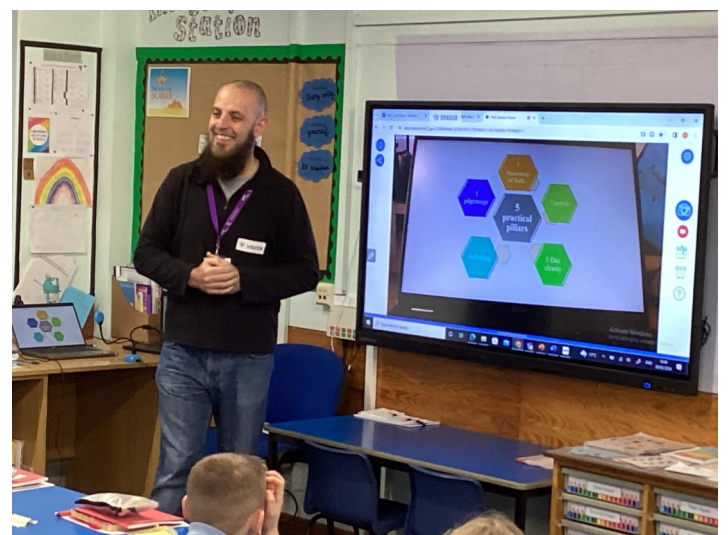
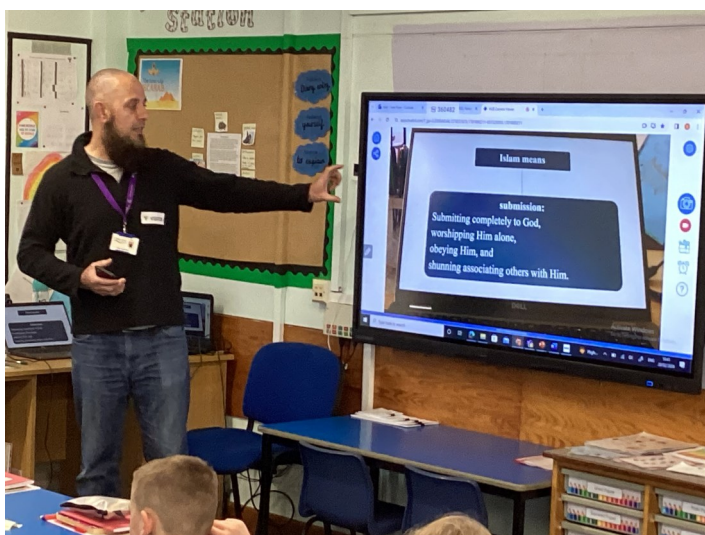

Year 3 have been working on their ball skills in PE this week. They have used the school value Co-operation to work in partners successfully bouncing and rolling their ball to each other.



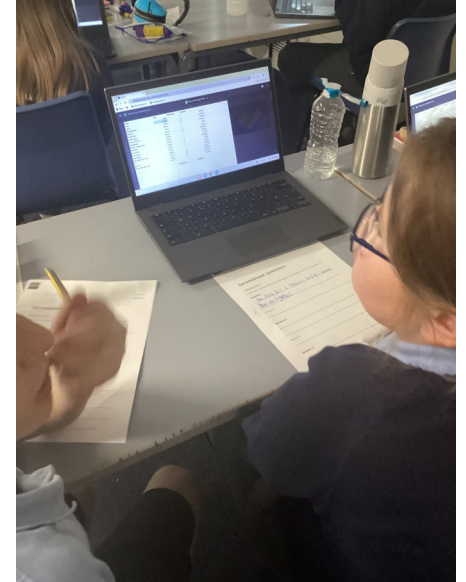
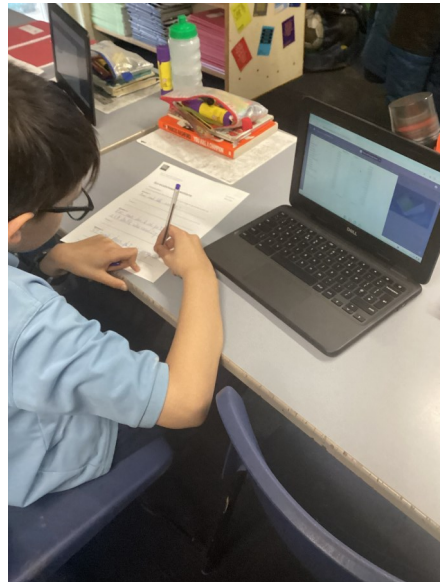
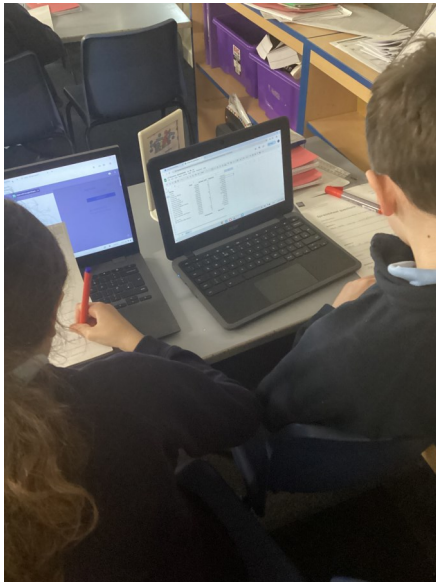
