The staff in Year 3 are very proud!

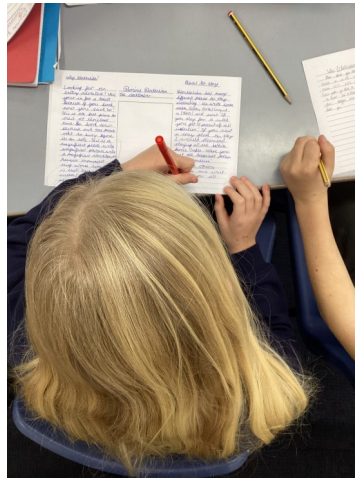
