In our RE lessons Reception have been learning about the Nativity Story. They have enjoyed acting out the story using the wooden characters.



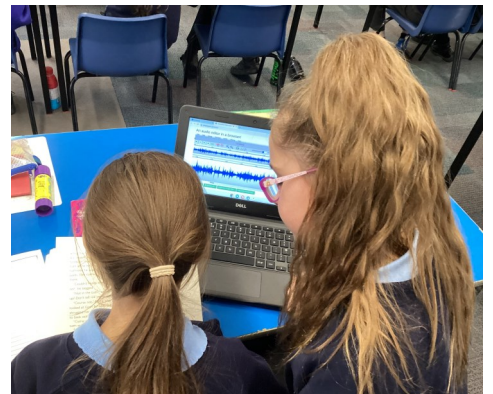
