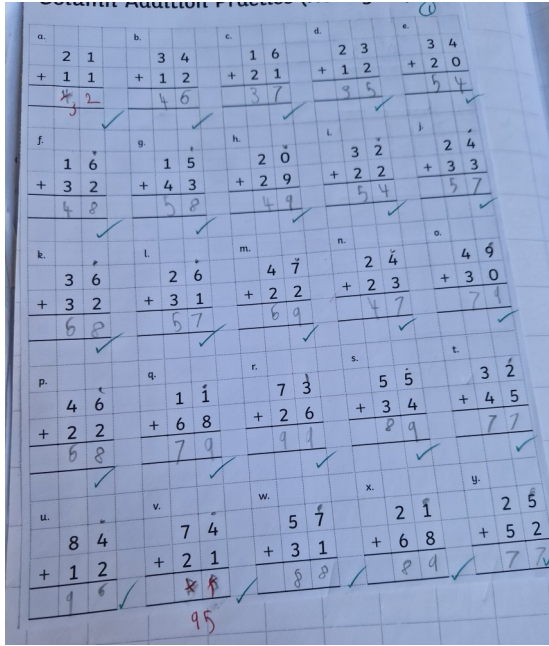


This week Reception visited St Michael's Church. They enjoyed looking at the different parts of a church and enjoyed a sing-song.

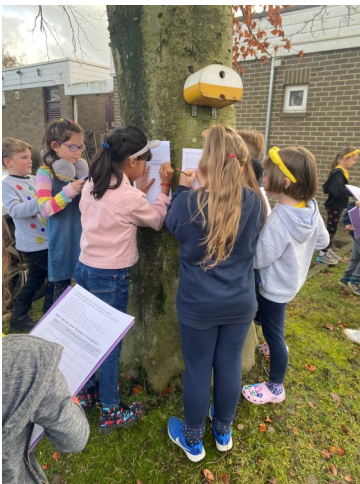

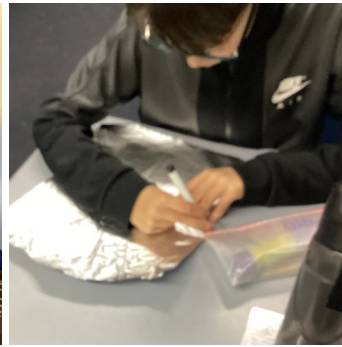
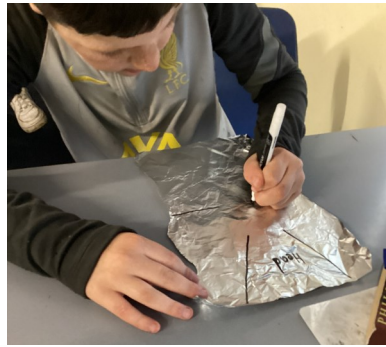


Year 4 have been learning all about the digestive system this week. We did a practical investigation so that we could fully understand the function of each part of the process. Although it was quite messy, the children thought it was a fun way to learn and remember how the parts of the digestive system work together. The children then wrote up the process in a flow chart using the scientific vocabulary they had learnt.

Year 6 have been learning about Alberto Giacometti, a fantastic sculpturer who used bronze to make tall, thin statues. We experimented using tin foil to make sculptures that all

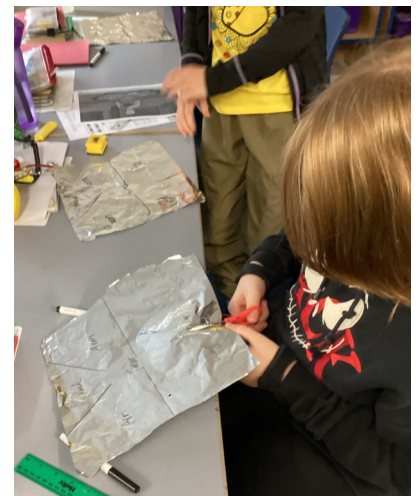
