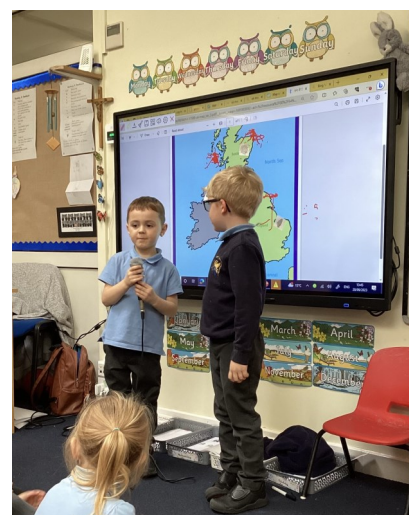
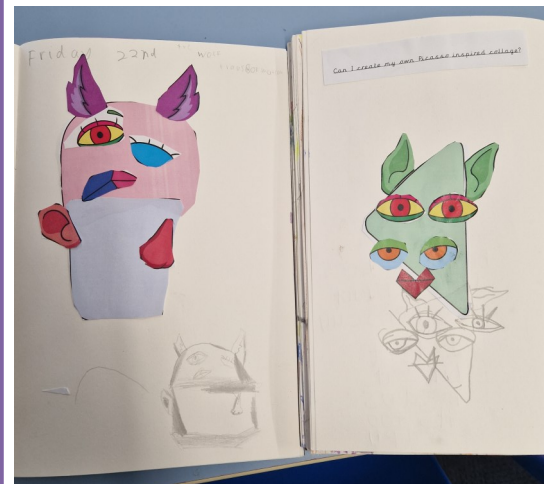
In Pre-School we have been talking about our homes and creating pictures of these. We have also been exploring different Autumn scents in our playdough.

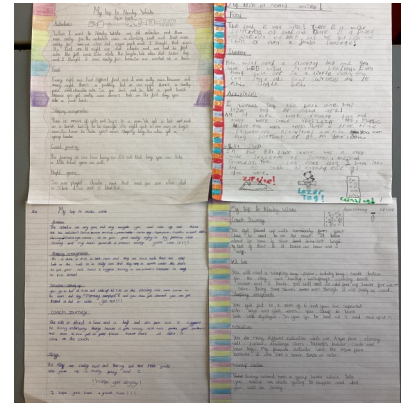
This week in PE, Year 3 were working on holding a balance. We enjoyed using the apparatus to create different balances with a partner. We had lots of fun too!
