Year 3 are developing their love of reading. They are keen to read their library books at any chance they get!



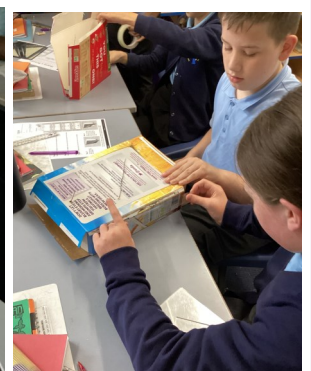
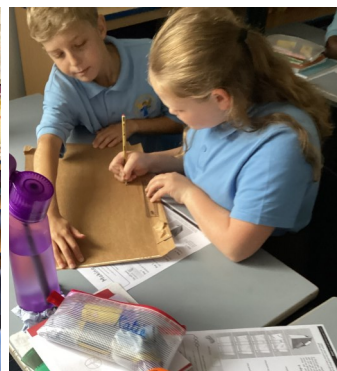
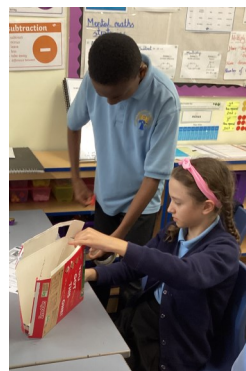
