Pre-School enjoyed taking part in Sports Day on Wednesday morning. We have too many photographs to have them all here so will be shortly be uploading the full set to our class page.

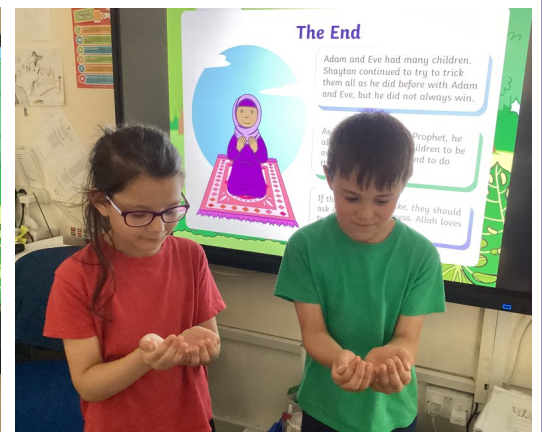
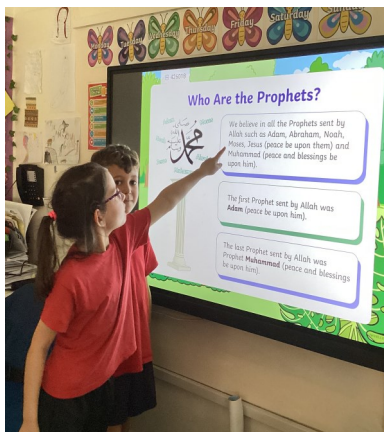

This week in English, Year 3 have been learning about recounts. The children have written a recount of their trip to Salts Mill. We're looking forward to sharing them with Year 2.



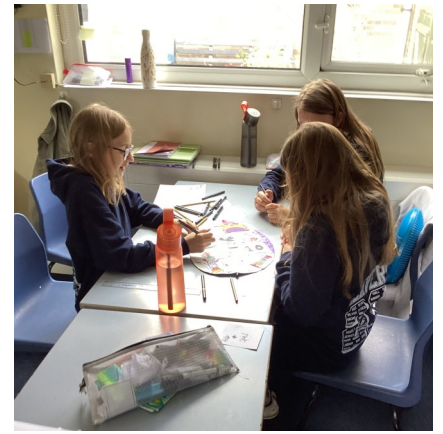
In Computing, year 4 have been learning about Programming – Repetition in games. This week they developed a design on Scratch that included two or more loops which run at the same time to animate their names.
