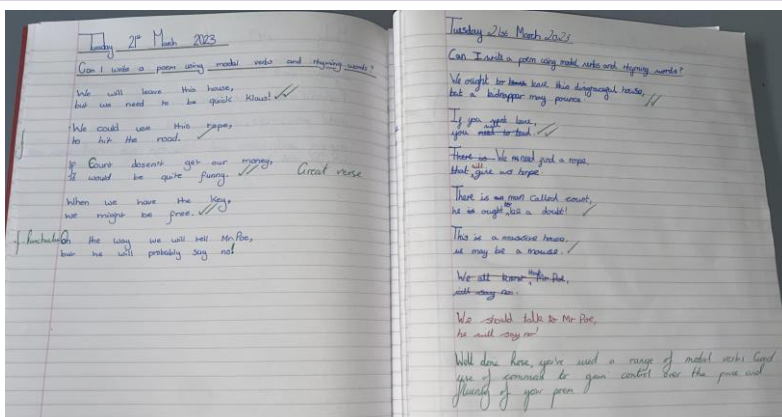
In Art, Year 3 have been learning about hot and cool colours. They drew a picture of a horizon and then used paints to demonstrate what they have learned.
