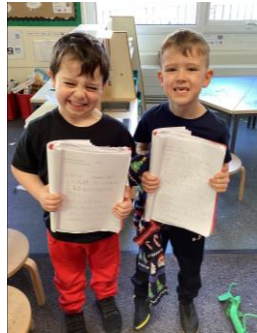

Reception have been reading Jack and the Beanstalk. As part of this the children retold the story and made their own parachutes to help Jack escape from the castle.

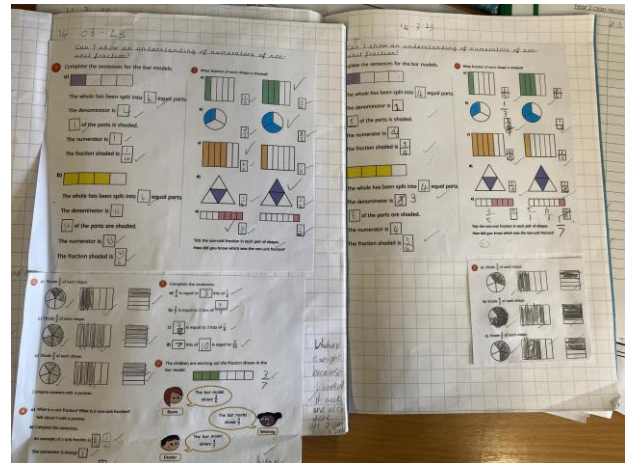

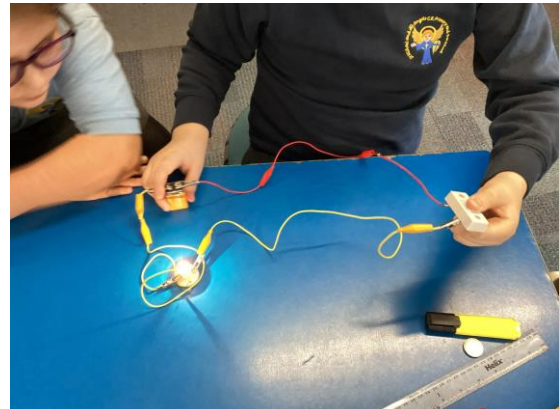
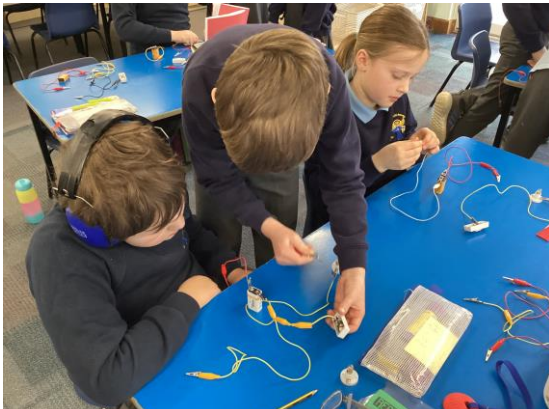


Year 2 have been practicing the techniques we need to use to make our African inspired thumb pots. We used salt dough to practice making our pots before we start making our final product.

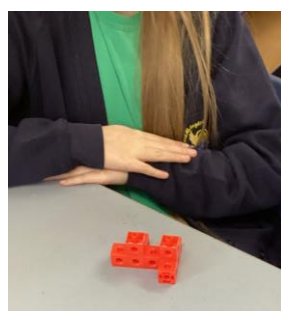

Year 4 have been learning how to put switches into their circuits to control the flow of electricity to the bulb. We worked in small groups to make different circuits that contained switches.



In RE, Year 5 have been learning about the story of Jesus. Firstly, they had a go at matching pictures to the different events that happened in his life. Then, they made a freeze frame of one of the events and the rest of the class had to guess what was happening.



In Maths, Year 6 have been learning about how to find the volume of any shape. We began our lesson by creating different shapes with the same volume by counting the cubes involved.
