



Pre-School and Reception have had fun playing in the snow!

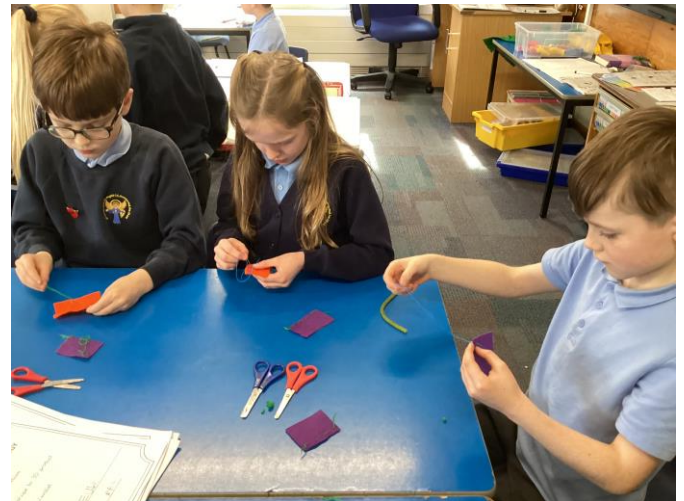
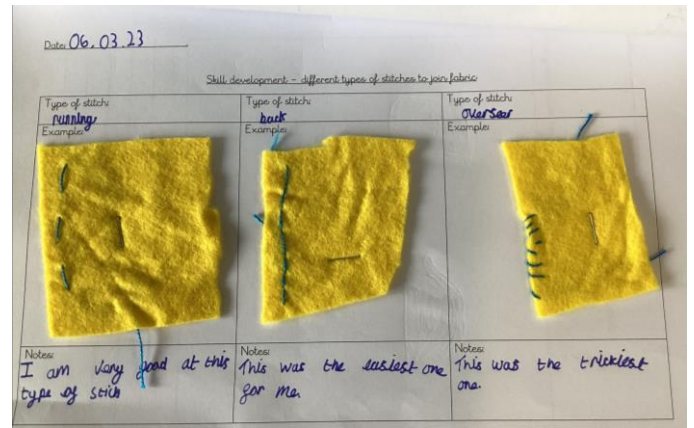
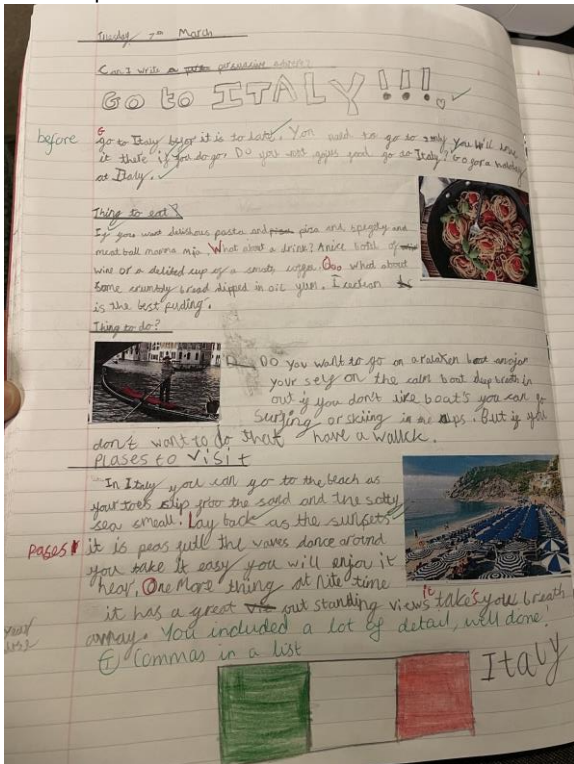

Year 4 have been learning how to sew three different types of stitches to prepare them for their Design Technology unit this half term. We learnt how to sew a running stitch, back stitch and overcast stitch. We also spent time looking at how to thread a needle and tie knots. Year 4 were very resilient even though this was tricky!



In DT, Year 5 have been learning about structures. We used mini gems and cocktail sticks to build our own mini structures and learnt how to increase the stability of the different models by incorporating triangles into the design. We then looked at real life examples.
