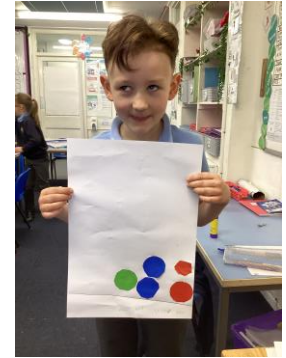
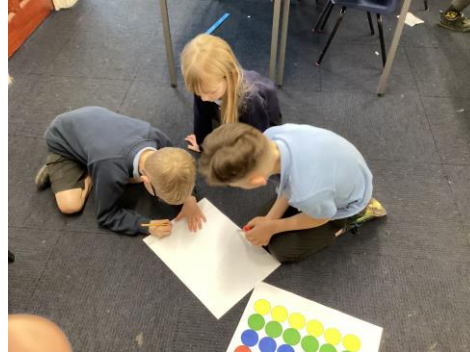


In Reception we have been learning about dinosaurs. We learnt about Mary Anning and how she found lots of fossils. We looked at different fossils and then created our own using salt dough.

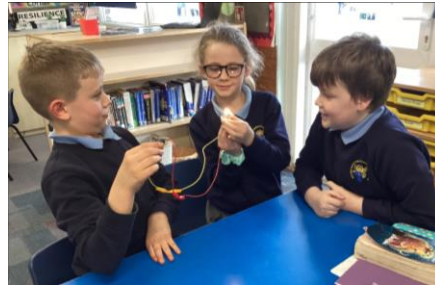

In Year 2 we have been looking at pictograms. Today we worked in groups making our own pictograms on our classes favourite colours. Next week we will start using the computers to represent the data.

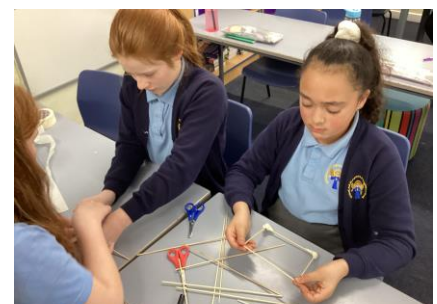
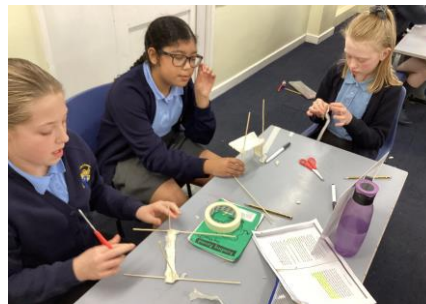
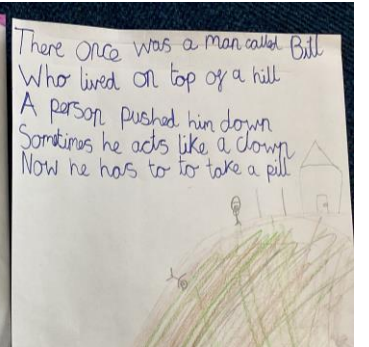
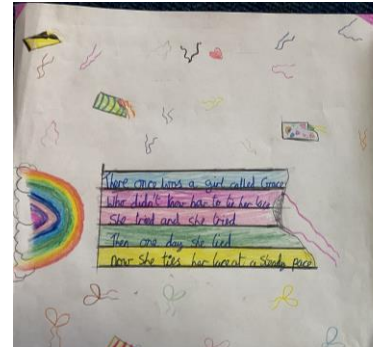
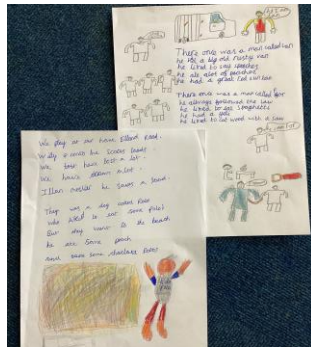


This week Year 3 set up a science investigation to find the best conditions to grow a healthy plant. We are excited to observe the changes over the next few weeks.
