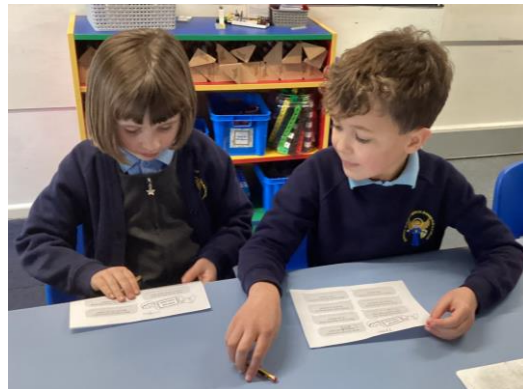


Early years are learning about people who help us, as part of this the police came to visit. The children enjoyed learning about the police, trying on the uniform and going in the police van.

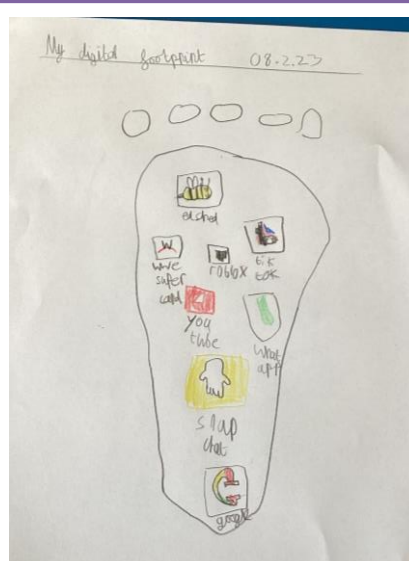
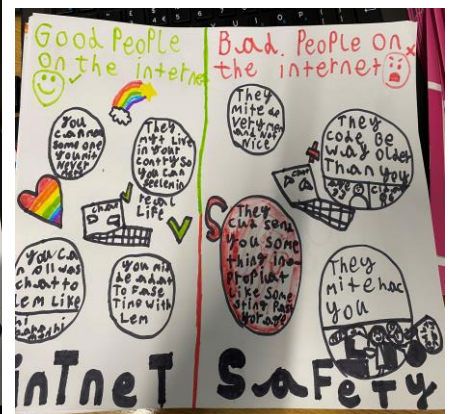
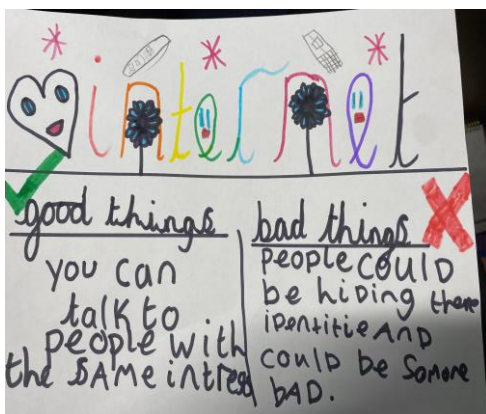
This week Year 1 learnt about online safety by acting out some scenarios they may be faced with when online. We talked about what to do if they were unsure about something online and learnt a song encouraging us to ask an adult for help if we needed it.



Year 2 discussed the way they used the internet, we talked about all the good things that we can do on the internet but also dangers that we need to be aware of. We read the story Hanni and the Magic Window and thought about what we could do if we saw something online that we shouldn't have seen and that may have upset us. We then interviewed each other on our online habits.



Year 3 discussed good and bad things about communicating on the internet. We then put that information onto posters for others to see.



This week Year 4 have been looking at our digital footprints, and how our information can be shared with others by what we do online. We looked at how we use the internet and how to keep our personal information private. We also discussed how to be safe online and not click on unknown links or open attachments from people we don't know.



Year 5 discussed different scenarios and helped each other to identify how to stay safe online. They gave each other top tips on how to look after themselves on the websites that they commonly use and where and when it is ok to give out personal information.



Year 6 looked at different scenarios they could face when using the internet, through useful discussions and partner work they decided what the best option would be to deal with that scenario. We then also looked at an element of the internet they wanted to change. They shared what they thought the Government, parents, website designers and pupils could do to support their change for the good.
