This week in Pre-School we have been talking about Chinese New Year, exploring noodles and making lanterns. We have also been looking at shapes and their properties and making repeating patterns.



This week Reception have been learning about the lunar new year. We made dragon masks, puppets and learnt how people across the world celebrate.



Year 1 have been using the maths resources this week to help them understand the numbers 10 to 20. We used the resources in different ways and built different amounts to represent the numbers we needed. This really helped us to answer our questions independently.
