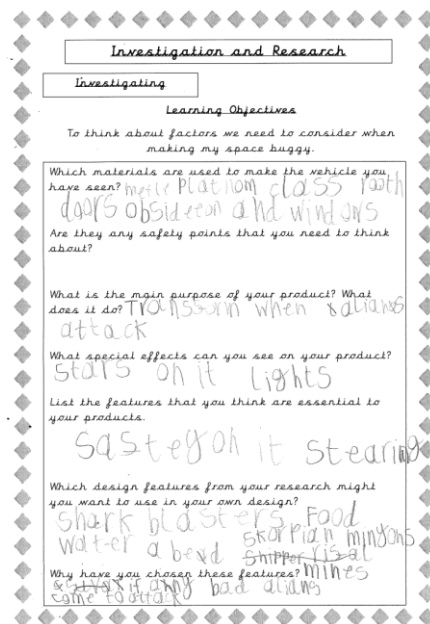


On Monday Reception really enjoyed listening to stories read by different grown ups.

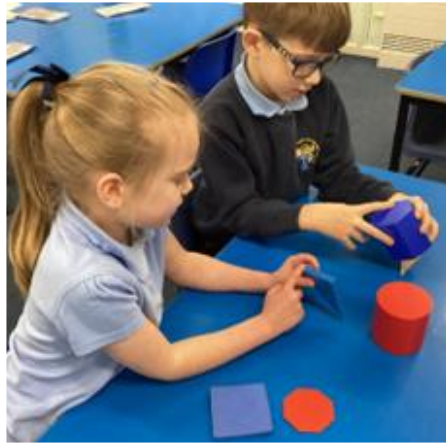
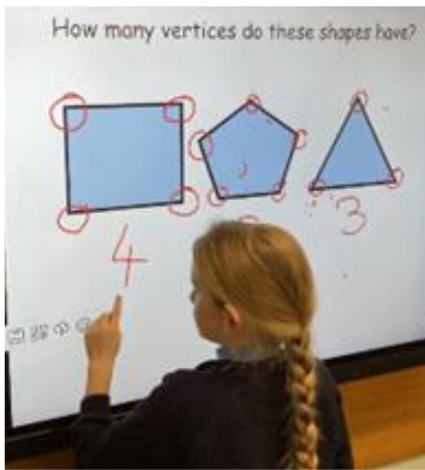

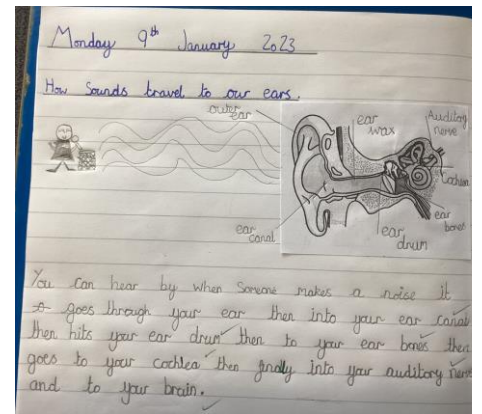
Year 1 started their new science topic by looking at the different parts of the human body. Together we drew around someone and added labels to show each part of the body, discussing why they were important. The class blew us away with their brilliant knowledge.

Year 3 have been enthusiastically looking at the properties of shapes. Throughout the week, we have focused on recognising a variety of 2D and 3D shapes and counted the number of sides and vertices. Year 4 have been working on a new science topic all about sound. We learnt how sound is made and how we hear and interpret the sound.
