This week in Pre-School we have been enjoying listening to the Nativity story and today we have enjoyed putting our decorations up.



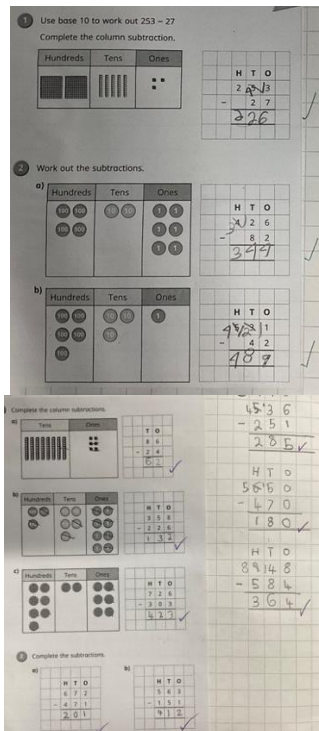
This week in Reception we have been reading 'The Jolly Christmas Postman'. We set up a Post Office role play area and have been enjoying writing and posting letters to each other.

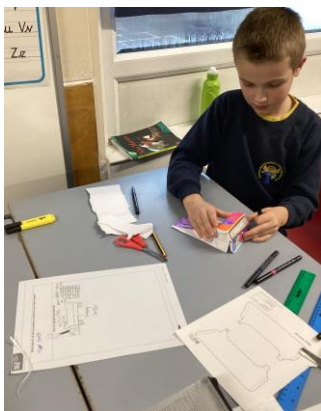




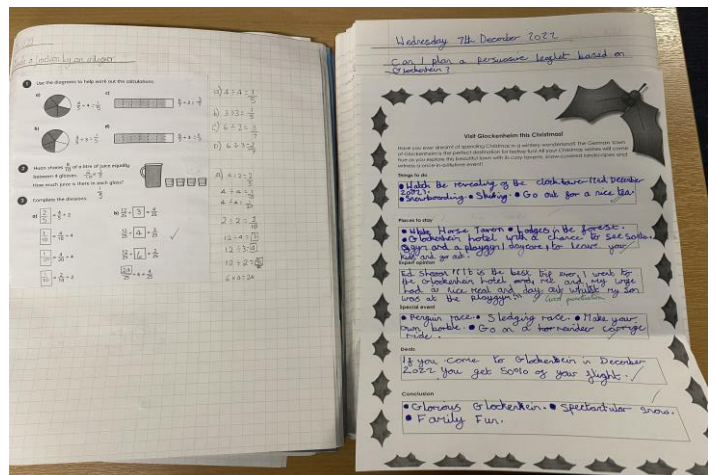

Year 4 have been investigating what effect different drinks have on our teeth. We have used tea, milk, orange juice, coca cola, vimto and water. Although some of our findings were as we expected, we were shocked at just how much damage vimto and orange juice can do to your teeth!



This half term, Year 5 have enjoyed their DT project - Alarming Vehicles. They used their understanding of electrical circuits and switches to produce an alarmed vehicle.
