In Reception this week we have been learning about the nativity story. We used the small world characters to act the story out.



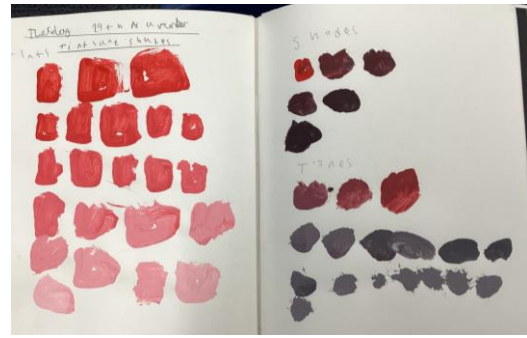

Year 2 have enjoyed having the parents in for our reading lesson this week. We would like to thank all the parents that came to make the lesson so special.



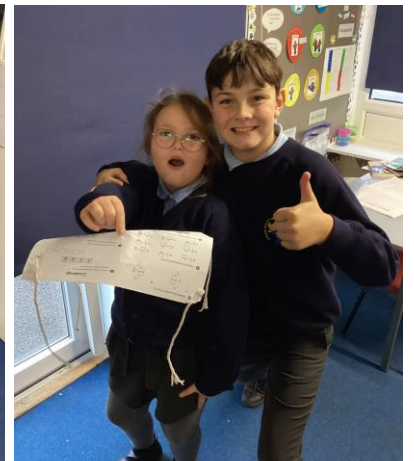

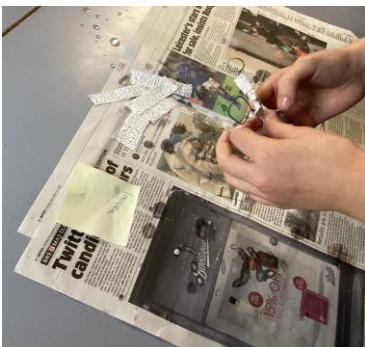


Year 4 have been learning how to mix their own tints, shades and tones of colour. We experimented to see how many different tints and shades of red we could find. To make tints we added different amounts of white, to make shades we added different amounts of black and to make tones we added different amounts of grey. This will be really useful when we learn about Aboriginal art next week and try to create our own pieces using tints and shades of red, orange and brown.

In our science lesson Year 5 learnt about air resistance and how it can have both a positive and negative impact. We did a practical experiment to try and figure out what the safest type of parachute would look like.



Year 6 have been using Modrock to create their own sculpture. We needed to layer the Modrock up to make our sculpture stronger.
