

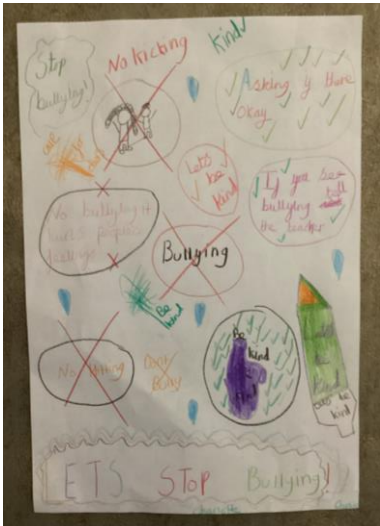


## Interfaith week
