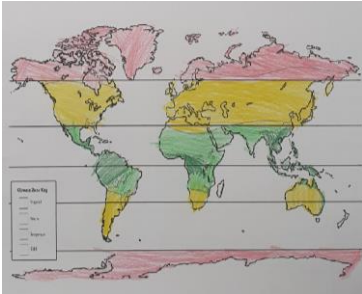


This week in Reception we have been learning about our families. Over the week we have listened to lots of stories about different families. Then the children painted pictures of their own.

This week in Year 2 we have been learning about hot and child climates. We used a map to locate where they are in the world.

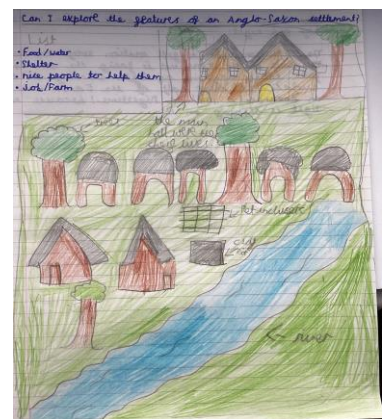
