Today the children have had a film reward; this was to recognise how they demonstrated our school values when we had visitors in school this week.

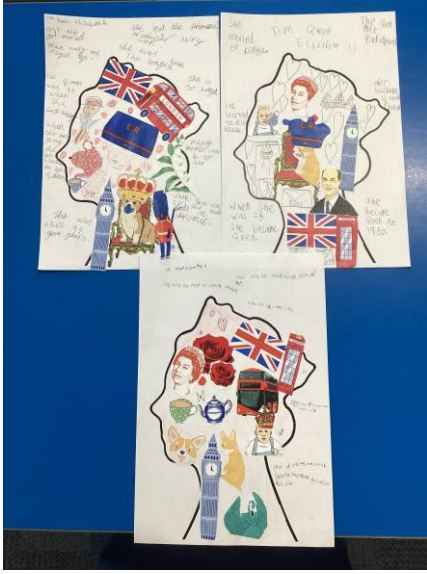


Reception enjoyed balancing on beams during our PE lesson.

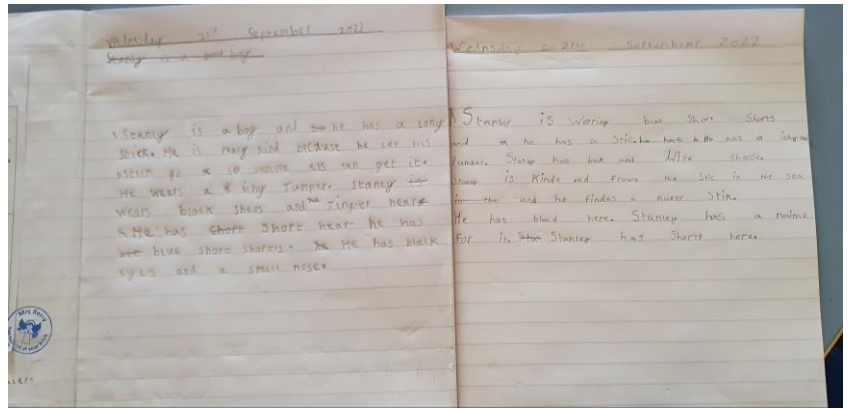

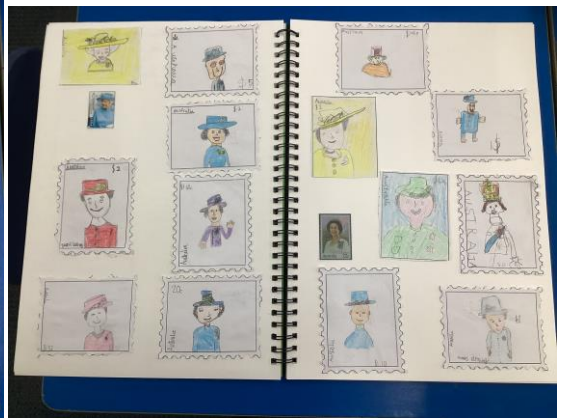
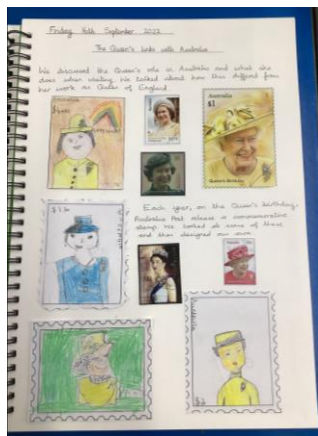
Year 3 celebrated the life of Queen Elizabeth II. We created collages using images and words to describe her.



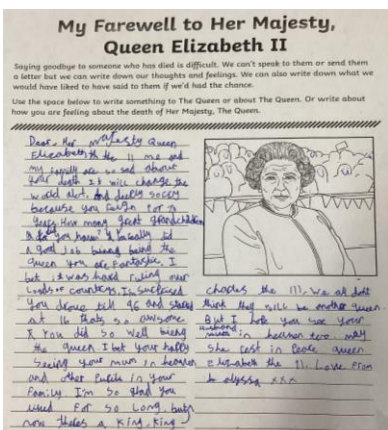
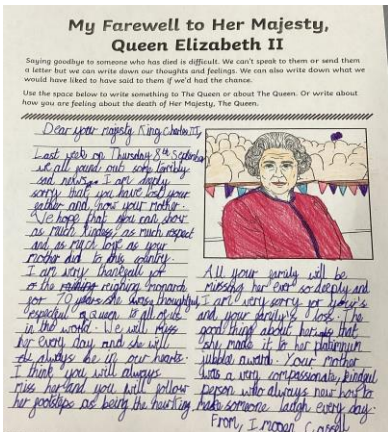
This week Year 2 had their first independent write. We are super proud of how well we coped with this and how much we were able to write on our own. These are a few of our examples.
