In Pre-School we have been harvesting the vegetables that we have grown over the summer. We looked at their different sizes and shapes and enjoyed eating some for our snack!

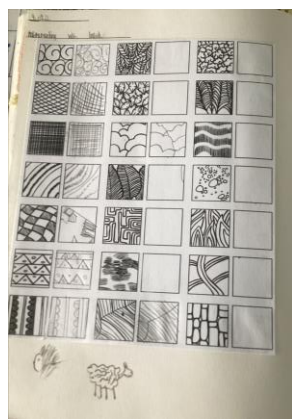
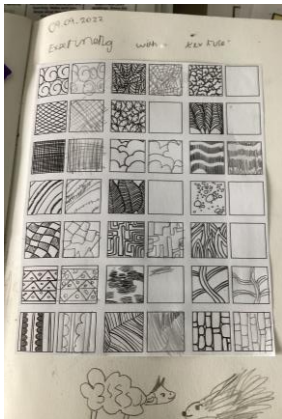
