Clubs Spring Term

Please see the following for details of the extra-curricular clubs on offer after the Christmas break.

Monday - Forest School - Year 3 and 4

Forest School will be run by an external provider, after school on Mondays 3:15 - 4:30pm, starting on 6th January until 10th February. This will be priced at £24 for 6 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers. Forest School will be held outside on the school grounds in the nature garden. Children will need warm, waterproof clothing and suitable footwear such as walking boots or wellington boots, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag.

Monday - Lego Builder Club - Year 1 and Year 2

Lego Builder club will be run by an external provider the 'Bricktopia team' after school on Mondays 3:15 until 4:15pm, starting on 6th January until 10th February. The Lego Builder club provides fun and engaging activities, using LEGO bricks. It encourages children to use their imaginations across a number of building activities providing inspiration, a chance to work in partnership, and to problem solve whilst having plenty of fun! They use a variety of building activities across the programme which is tailored to the children's abilities and interests. This club will be priced at £33 for 6 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers.

Year 5 and 6 Cricket

Mr Barker will continue to run a cricket club after school on Thursdays until 4:15pm. After the holidays this will restart on Thursday 9th January and will run till Thursday 13th February. If your child currently has a place at the after-school cricket club this will continue for them after the Christmas holidays. If you would not like this place, please contact the school office. A couple of further places are available if you wish to sign your child up, please ask at the school office. Children will need appropriate sports clothing and trainers, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag.

Please note that the process for booking the above mentioned clubs is as follows:-

1. Online forms for clubs relevant to your child's year group will be emailed and a limited number of places become live for bookings tomorrow (Thursday 12th December) at 6pm.
2. Complete and submit the form if you would like to book a club place.
3. You will immediately get a thank you message confirming that your child has been allocated a place if there are places available.
4. If all the places have been allocated, you will not be able to submit the form. If you would like to add your child's name to a waiting list you can do so by [emailing us](#).
5. If a charge is applicable this will be set up and emailed for payment on SchoolMoney to be paid for before the club starts. If payment is not received, we reserve the right to cancel the place and offer it to someone on the waiting list.

Clay Team Club

Clay Team Club will be restarting on a Thursday for Years 1 to 6 after the February half term break, running for 6 weeks Thursday 27th February until Thursday 3rd April. Bookings will again be made directly with The Clay Team and priority booking will be offered to those who are already on the waiting list. This club will cost £33 for the 6 weeks and details will follow in the New Year about making bookings for this.

Please speak to your child to check they want to attend the clubs you have signed up for. If your child doesn't want to attend the club and therefore doesn't engage or fails to attend regularly, they will be asked to give their place to someone on our waiting list. This is to ensure that children who want to attend the clubs have the opportunity to do so. Additionally, if children's behaviour is not in line with school expectations, they will be asked to not attend the club in future.
