### **Clubs Spring 2 Term**

Please see the following for details of the extra-curricular clubs on offer after the February half term break.

#### **Forest School, Year 5 and 6 - Monday**

Forest School will be run by an external provider, after school on Mondays 3:15 - 4:30pm, starting on 24<sup>th</sup> February until 31<sup>st</sup> March. This will be priced at £24 for 6 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers. Forest School will be held outside on the school grounds in the nature garden. Children will need warm, waterproof clothing and suitable footwear such as walking boots or wellington boots, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag.

#### **Lego Builder Club, Year 3 and 4 - Monday**

Lego Builder club will be run by an external provider the 'Bricktopia team' after school on Mondays 3:15 until 4:15pm, starting on 24<sup>th</sup> February until 31<sup>st</sup> March. The Lego Builder club provides fun and engaging activities, using LEGO bricks. It encourages children to use their imaginations across a number of building activities providing inspiration, a chance to work in partnership, and to problem solve whilst having plenty of fun! They use a variety of building activities across the programme which is tailored to the children's abilities and interests. This club will be priced at £33 for 6 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers.

#### **Choir, Year 4 and 5 - Tuesday**

Miss Thomas will be holding choir club for the same children who attended in the Autumn Term. If your child no longer wants to take part please email us (link on following page). This club will be held after school on Tuesdays until 4:00pm, starting on 25<sup>th</sup> February until 1<sup>st</sup> April. We will be entering a choir competition against other schools in Calderdale; more details to follow.

#### **Football, Year 5 and 6 - Thursday**

Mr Barker will run a football club after school on Thursdays until 4:15pm, starting on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> February until Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> April. Children will need appropriate sports clothing and trainers, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag.

### **Clay Club, Year 1 to 6 - Thursday**

Clay Club will be restarting on a Thursday for Years 1 to 6, starting on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> February until 3<sup>rd</sup> April. Priority booking will be available to those who are already on the waiting list; this will be via a link and a password which will be sent by a text message on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> February at 6pm; please do not share the password. All remaining places will become available for 'general admission' booking via a link and the password which will be sent by a text message on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February at 6pm. Places will cost £33 for the 6 weeks and should be booked and paid for directly to the Clay Team.

Please note that the process for booking clubs is generally as follows, the exception this time is Clay Club and this is detailed above.

1. Online forms for clubs relevant to your child's year group will be emailed and a limited number of places become live for bookings on Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> February at 6pm.
2. Complete and submit the form if you would like to book a club place.
3. You will immediately get a thank you message confirming that your child has been allocated a place if there are places available.
4. If all the places have been allocated, you will not be able to submit the form. If you would like to add your child's name to a waiting list you can do so by [emailing us](#).
5. If a charge is applicable, this will be set up and emailed for payment on SchoolMoney to be paid for before the club starts. The exception to this is Clay Club for which booking and payment is made directly to the Clay Team. If a club payment is not received, we reserve the right to cancel the place and offer it to someone on the waiting list.

Please speak to your child to check they want to attend the clubs you have signed up for. If your child doesn't want to attend the club and therefore doesn't engage or fails to attend regularly, they will be asked to give their place to someone on our waiting list. This is to ensure that children who want to attend the clubs have the opportunity to do so. Additionally, if children's behaviour is not in line with school expectations, they will be asked to not attend the club in future.
