



The children also made shadow puppets of their favourite characters. After making them the children enjoyed playing with them outside.




The Great Chicken Mystery by Melanie Joyce

Ava said that her book was about scientists and that it inspired her because it told their journeys of becoming scientists.


Seb told the class how his book inspired him to try writing his own comic strip. The children brought in a great selection and we enjoyed looking at them all.
