Clubs Summer 1

Please see the following for details of the extra-curricular clubs on offer after the Easter holidays.

Forest School, Year 1 and 2 - Mondays

Forest School will be run by an external provider, after school on Mondays 3:15 - 4:30pm, starting on **28th April until 7th July** (excluding 5th May due to the bank holiday). This will be priced at £36 for 9 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers. Forest School will be held outside on the school grounds in the nature garden. Children will need warm, waterproof clothing and suitable footwear such as walking boots or wellington boots, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag. Please note this club will run the whole Summer Term, except for the final week of term. Payment for this club will be due by 20th April.

Lego Builder Club, Year 5 and 6 - Mondays

Lego Builder club will be run by an external provider the 'Bricktopia team' after school on Mondays 3:15 until 4:15pm, starting on **28th April until 7th July** (excluding 5th May due to the bank holiday). The Lego Builder club provides fun and engaging activities, using LEGO bricks. It encourages children to use their imaginations across a number of building activities providing inspiration, a chance to work in partnership, and to problem solve whilst having plenty of fun! They use a variety of building activities across the programme which is tailored to the children's abilities and interests. This club will be priced at £49.50 for 9 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers. Please note this club will run the whole Summer Term, except for the final week of term. Payment for this club will be due by 20th April.

Gardening Club, Reception and Year 1 - Tuesdays

Miss Mitchell will be running an extra-curricular gardening club that will be open to children in Reception and Year 1. This will take place on Tuesdays **22nd April to 20th May**, after school until 4:15pm. As we will be running these sessions outside, children will need appropriate footwear and coats on the day. There will be a cost of £2.50 for the 5 weeks of gardening club sessions in order to pay for resources needed and as always, any donations of gardening items would be greatly appreciated. A £2.50 charge will be added to your SchoolMoney account if your child is allocated a place in gardening club and will be payable by 20th April.

Netball Club, Years 4 and 5 - Thursdays

Miss Burt will be running a netball club for Year 4 and 5 children. This will take place each Thursday (**24th April to 22nd May**) after school until 4:00pm. Year 5 have PE on a Thursday so will already be in their PE kit but Year 4 should bring their PE kit to change into after school. Weather permitting, this club will take place outside but if not, it will be in the school hall.

Please note that the process for booking clubs is as follows

1. Online forms for clubs relevant to your child's year group will be emailed and a limited number of places become live for bookings on **Monday 31st March at 6pm.**
2. Complete and submit the form if you would like to book a club place.
3. You will immediately get a thank you message confirming that your child has been allocated a place if there are places available.
4. If all the places have been allocated, you will not be able to submit the form. If you would like to add your child's name to a waiting list you can do so by [emailing us](#).
5. If a charge is applicable, this will be set up and emailed for payment on SchoolMoney to be paid for before the club starts. If a club payment is not received, we reserve the right to cancel the place and offer it to someone on the waiting list.

Please speak to your child to check they want to attend the clubs you have signed up for. If your child doesn't want to attend the club and therefore doesn't engage or fails to attend regularly, they will be asked to give their place to someone on our waiting list. This is to ensure that children who want to attend the clubs have the opportunity to do so. Additionally, if children's behaviour is not line with school expectations, they will be asked to not attend the club in future.
