Clubs Autumn

Firstly, I would like to thank those of you that provided feedback regarding our after-school club provision. Your insights and suggestions are integral to our continuous improvement, and we greatly appreciate the time you took to share your thoughts with us.

After carefully considering your feedback, we are excited to announce that there will be some new additions to our after-school clubs in the academic year ahead. For Autumn term, these are a Judo Club and a Performing Arts Club.

Please see the following details of the extra-curricular clubs on offer this half term.

Forest School, Year 1 & 2 - Monday

Forest School will be run by an external provider, after school on Mondays 3:15 - 4:30pm, starting on **Monday 15th September until Monday 20th October**. This will be priced at £20 for 5 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers. Forest School will be held outside on the school grounds in the nature garden. Children will need warm, waterproof clothing and suitable footwear such as walking boots or wellington boots, and these should be sent each week in a named carrier bag. Please note the price reflects the school INSET day on Monday 6th October.

Science Club, Year 2 – Tuesday

Miss Burt will be running a science club after school on a Tuesday until 4:15pm, starting on **Tuesday 16th September until Tuesday 14th October**. This will be charged at £1 a week per child paid via SchoolMoney.

Judo Club, Year 3 & 4 – Tuesday

Judo Club will be run by an external provider, Judo Excellence, on Tuesdays 3:15 - 4:15pm, starting on **Tuesday 16th September until Tuesday 14th October**. This will be priced at £25 for 5 weeks; once places have been allocated a "payment due" for the amount will be set up on SchoolMoney and emailed to parents/carers.

Performing Arts, Year 1 to 6 – Thursday

Performing Arts Club will be run by an external provider, All Star Academy after school on a Thursday 3:15 – 4:15 starting on **Thursday 18th September** and running throughout the

academic year. This will be priced at £22 per month and paid directly to them. Please see the attached poster for further details.

How to book and pay:

Please note that the process for booking clubs is generally as follows, the exception this time is Performing Arts Club and this is detailed above.

1. Online forms for clubs relevant to your child's year group will be emailed and a limited number of places become live for bookings on **Thursday 11th September at 6:30pm.**

2. Complete and submit the form if you would like to book a club place.

3. You will immediately get a thank you message confirming that your child has been allocated a place if there are places available.

4. If all the places have been allocated, you will not be able to submit the form. If you would like to add your child's name to a waiting list you can do so by emailing us.

5. If a charge is applicable, this will be set up and emailed for payment on SchoolMoney to be paid for before the club starts. The exception to this is Performing Arts Club for which booking and payment is made directly to All Stars Academy. If a club payment is not received, we reserve the right to cancel the place and offer it to someone on the waiting list.

Please speak to your child to check they want to attend the clubs you have signed up for. If your child doesn't want to attend the club and therefore doesn't engage or fails to attend regularly, they will be asked to give their place to someone on our waiting list. This is to ensure that children who want to attend the clubs have the opportunity to do so. Additionally, if children's behaviour is not in line with school expectations, they will be asked to not attend the club in future.
